As we work through challenges including higher food prices, we continue to serve over 1,000 families per month, delivering to 150 seniors, providing meals for 310 young families from Columbus Early Learning Centers, and are blessed to have more than 330 volunteer hours each month helping to make our work possible.

COMPASS homelessness prevention services to Franklin County residents, helps to combat the nearly 2,000 monthly evictions, and assists an average of 100 households a month, with rent and utility assistance.

We continue to support neighborhood youth in our fast-growing tutoring program for Bronzeville Elementary School scholars, an expansion of the Bronzeville Communication Network and a neighborhood beautification program working with residents and the City of Columbus.
